A Candidate must have One Year in the Order from his *First Degree* date, to be eligible for the Fourth Degree Exemplification.

Waivers are available for those with *Six Months* or more. Waiver requests must be sent to the Master at least 30 days prior to the degree date. Please remember to press hard on the Form 4 making sure that the last copy can be read.

Complete all information on the form. First Degree date and membership number are very important. **Be sure to have the Financial Secretary of the Council, the Faithful Navigator Comptroller of the Assembly sign the Form 4.** Failure to follow these instructions can lead to a delay and the possibility of the candidate not taking the 4th degree

On behalf of the Officers of La Salle, we would like to wish and your families, a Very Blessed and Merry Christmas and all the Best for the New Year of 2008.

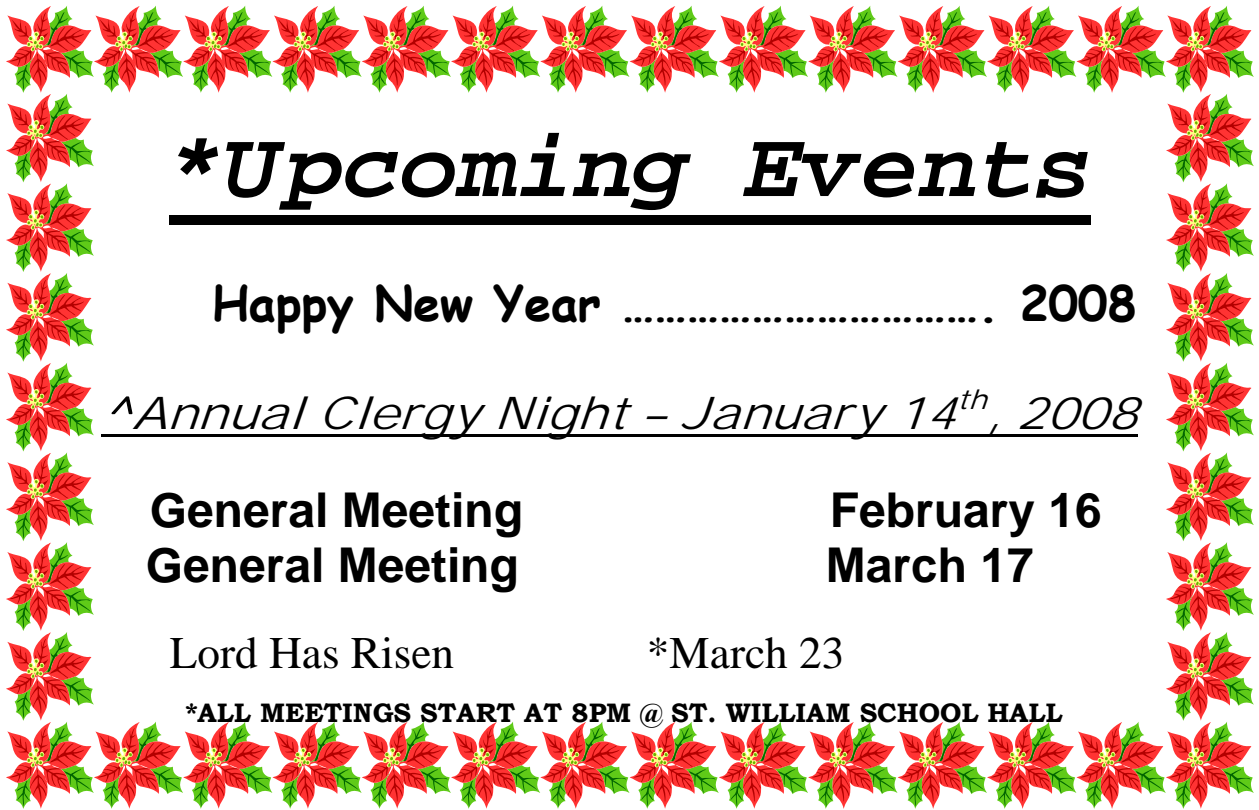
